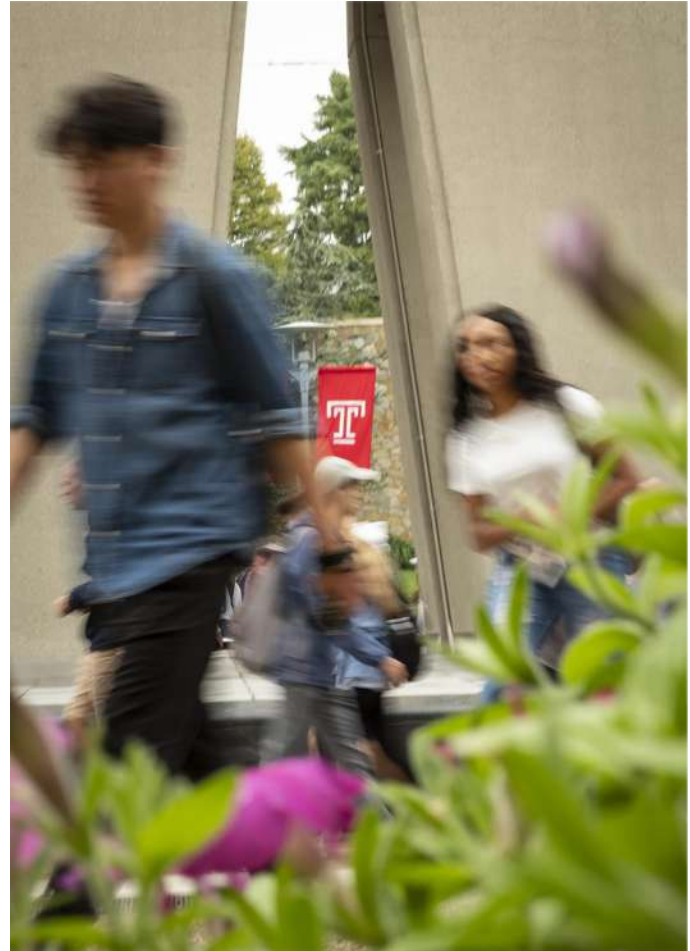

DBMD REQUIREMENTS



- Apply in 3rd or 4th year (Alumni too) with 3 or fewer remaining courses
- GPA 3.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale
- Language scores:
 - TOEFL Internet-Based (iBT) 79 (Minimum)
 - Fox Business School 90
 - Media and Communications 100
 - IELTS Academic 6.5 (Minimum)
 - Fox Business School 7.0
 - Media and Communications 7.0
 - Duolingo 110 (Minimum)
 - Fox Business School 110
 - Media and Communications 120
- GMAT or GRE required for Business (waivers possible)
 - Minimum scores 59th to 80th percentile depending on major

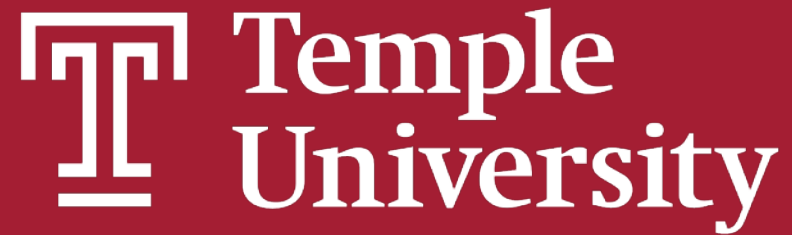
